This is to inform the St. Augustine University of Tanzania (SAUT) community and the general public that on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> December 2023 the Council of St. Augustine University of Tanzania in its 76<sup>th</sup> meeting approved promotions of the following members of academic staff to the various academic ranks as shown below.

**A: From Senior Lecturer to Associate Professor:**

**1. Prof. Angelo Sadock Nyamtema: Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology:**



Since his last academic promotion to Senior Lecturer in 2012, **Prof. Nyamtema** has earned a total of **17 points** (15 from scholarly works, 2 from community services).

**2. Prof. Nicholas J. Kavana: Department of Parasitology and Microbiology:**



Since his last academic promotion to Senior Lecturer in 2012, **Prof. Kavana** has earned a total of **12.5 points** (10.5 from scholarly works, 1 from administrative duties and special assignment and 1 from teaching).

**3. Prof. Albino Kalolo: Department of Public Health:**



Since his last academic promotion to Senior Lecturer in 2016, **Prof. Kalolo** has earned a total of **36.95 points** (33.30 from scholarly works, 2.65 from administrative duties and special assignment and 1 from teaching).

**1. Dr. Prosperity Mwansa Mwila: Department of Education Foundation:**



Since his last academic promotion to Lecturer in 2020, **Dr. Mwila** earned a total of **11.5 points** (8.9 from scholarly works, 2.6 from community services).

**2. Dr. David H. Mrisho: Department of Public Relations and Advertising:**



Since his last academic promotion to Lecturer in 2020, **Dr. Mrisho** earned a total of **6.7 points** (3.7 from scholarly works, 3.0 from community services and consultancies).

**3. Sr. Dr. Michaela Mhagama: Department of Education Foundation:**



Since her last academic promotion to Lecturer in 2019, **Sr. Dr. Mhagama** earned a total of **10.2 points** (7.2 from scholarly works, 3.0 from community services and consultancies).

Since his employment as Assistant Lecturer in 2014, **Mr. Badokufa** has earned a total of **8.7 points**, (4.0 from scholarly works, and 4.73 from community services).

**2. Mr. Delphine Kamugisha: Department of Education Foundation:**



Since his employment as Assistant Lecturer in 2012, **Mr. Kamugisha** has earned a total of **12.4 points**, (10.4 from scholarly works, and 2.0 from community services).

Since his employment as Assistant Lecturer in 2009, **Mr. Herman** has earned a total of **7.6 points**, (4.3 from scholarly works, and 3.3 from community services).
