ACADEMIC PROMOTIONS

This is to inform the St. Augustine University of Tanzania (SAUT) community and the general public that on Thursday 2nd May 2024 the Council of St. Augustine University of Tanzania in its 77th meeting approved promotions of the following members of academic staff to the various academic ranks as shown below.

A: From Senior Lecturer to Associate Professor:

1. Prof. Negussie Domnic Andre: Department of Philosophy and Ethics:



Since his last academic promotion to Senior Lecturer in 2020, **Prof. Negussie** has earned a total of **17.39 points** (13.14 from scholarly works, 3.25 from community services and 1.0 from teaching and supervision).

3. Rev. Dr. Paskas Wagana: Department of Sociology and Development Studies:



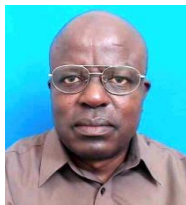
