#### **Introduction**

The Saint Augustine University of Tanzania (SAUT), founded in 1998 and owned by the Tanzania Episcopal Conference (TEC), is celebrating her silver jubilee in November this year. Over the years, as a successor to the then Nyegezi Social Training Institute (NSTI), the university has been engaged in their global triple *munera*: teaching, research and community service. To mark this august occasion, inter alia, the university has planned an institutional conference to be held in June followed by an international one in November 2023.

This notice, therefore, serves as a call for papers for the institutional conference. Members of the university community are asked to submit their papers to that end. Different themes are invited in this regard from, but not limited to, the following listed ones for discussion.

#### **Themes**

- Theme 1:** University (SAUT) History, Development and Management;
- Theme 2:** University and Society, Research and Community Services;
- Theme 3:** University Governance and Management and University Transformations;
- Theme 4:** Business, Economics, Geography, Tourism and Hospitality Management;
- Theme 5:** Religion, Religious Studies, Philosophy and Ethics;
- Theme 6:** Education, Learning and Knowledge Management;
- Theme 7:** Public Policy, Law, Justice and Human Rights;
- Theme 8:** Sociology, History, Culture and Rural Economy;
- Theme 9:** Journalism, Mass Communication and Public Relations;
- Theme 10:** Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics;
- Theme 11:** Cross cutting Issues: Sustainability and environmental management; Public-Private Partnership; Gender issues; Industry 4.0; Climate change; Ethical leadership, Corporate Governance and Social responsibility.
- Theme 12:** Any other related topic.

## Submissions

Submissions should be either as a research paper (empirical, conceptual or theoretical paper) or a practitioner paper (case study, position paper, occasional paper or working paper) paper; but, should be preceded by an abstract of about 200 words with up to five key words. The languages used: **English, Kiswahili and French**. Upon acceptance, authors will be asked to submit their full paper. Depending on type of a paper to be submitted, such full papers must have: an introduction, theoretical/conceptual analysis, brief literature, methodology, findings and analysis/discussions, conclusions and recommendations as appropriate.

Interested parties are urged to submit an abstract from 08<sup>th</sup> May 2023 to 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2023 through the following e-mail address: [academicconference25@saut.ac.tz](mailto:academicconference25@saut.ac.tz) captioned: **Institutional Conference and Theme (and your Name)**. Only original submissions are accepted. Authors will be asked also to prepare a summary of about 1,500 to 2,000 words of their work for alternative conference publication.

Each department is required to prepare at least a paper for presentation (as a department) and its members are also highly encouraged to do so individually. Owing the nature of the event attendance of the members of academic staff to the conference especially will be **mandatory**.
